

# Vote No on Tax Increase on April 8th

**The Doña Ana Soil and Water Conservation District wants to raise your property taxes to support its radical political agenda.**

**A special election is scheduled on April 8. The only question on the ballot is a proposed mil levy to raise \$350,000 in operating funds for the District.**

- The District doesn't have a plan that guarantees broad public benefit from these taxes;
- The District's board has taken many anti-environmental positions, including opposing the Organ Mountains-Desert Peaks National Monument, opposing wildlife recovery in the Southwest, and opposing regional planning for sustainable development;
- The board's chair has said that districts are needed to guard against the "tyranny of the federal government" and "environmental cartels;"
- The proposed mil levy would amount to double taxation within the City of Las Cruces, where a portion of gross receipts taxes are already used for flood control projects.
